

## **TRAVEL TO TOURNAMENT PROCEDURES**

**TEAMS THAT WANT TO TRAVE INSTATE OR OUT OF STATE TO PLAY IN TOURNAMENTS MUST REQUEST PERMISSION FROM SOCCER RHODE ISLAND.**

**A four-part form (out of State Travel) must be completed and sent to the State administrator for approval, at least thirty (30) days prior to playing games in the USA or at least ninety (90) days prior to traveling to a foreign country. This includes Mexico and Canada. Travel outside of the United States requires the approval of USSF.**

**REMEMBER TO PRESS FIRMLY ON THE FORM, THE INFORMATION MUST BE ON ALL FOUR COPIES.**

**THREE ROSTERS OF ALL PLAYERS AND TEAM OFFICIALS WITH I.D. NUMBERS FOR THE PLAYERS MUST BE SUBMITTED WITH EACH PERMISSION TO TRAVEL FORM. ROSTER MUST BE COMPLETELY FILLED OUT AND MUST BE TYPED.**

**The name of the tournament the coach is attending must be put at the top of the roster. You must also submit a copy of the “Application to Host Form” from the tournament you are entering. Two stamped envelopes addressed to the Tournament Director and to the applying Coach must accompany the Travel Form.**

**The Spring Coordinator or the President of your Association must sign all travel rosters.**

**Player passes must be carried by any team traveling outside of the jurisdiction of its’ own State Youth Association. Teams should also carry written medical releases from parents in case emergency medical care is required.**

**If your team is playing in any tournaments or games in Rhode Island, you must submit a one-part form and three copies of your roster to the State Administrator. You must also submit two stamped, addressed envelopes, one to the Tournament Director and one to the applying coach. This must be done thirty (30) days in advance of the tournament.**

**All Tournaments SRI teams are attending require a stamped and signed roster by the State Registrar before being permitted to play. This is for All Tournaments.**

**Any coach not following this procedure will be put in bad standing with SRI and may fined. There is a fine if paperwork is not sent to the State Administrator thirty days in advance of a tournament.**
